



WELCOME TO BUFFALO RIDGE REGIONAL TRANSIT!

Buffalo Ridge Regional Transit is a coordinated effort by the four public transportation systems in Southwestern Minnesota to increase access to needed goods and services throughout Murray, Nobles, Pipestone, and Rock Counties.

Buffalo Ridge Regional Transit is a partnership between:

- Murray County Heartland Express
- Nobles County Heartland Express / Prairieland Transit System
- Pipestone County Transit
- Rock County Heartland Express.

WHAT IS BUFFALO RIDGE REGIONAL TRANSIT (BRRT) ROUTE SERVICE?

Buffalo Ridge Regional Transit travels through fourteen communities in Murray, Nobles, Pipestone, and Rock counties on a designated route service. Each county will operate an accessible vehicle on scheduled days to provide access to goods and services throughout southwestern Minnesota. These routes are available Monday through Thursday. (Some holidays may not be available.)

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO RIDE ON THE BRRT ROUTE?

The cash fare for a round trip on the route service is \$15.00. You pay the driver \$15.00 when boarding the bus. Buffalo Ridge Regional Transit drivers cannot make change. Passengers need to pay the exact fare amount. This \$15.00 fare is for a round trip. You will receive 2 transfer tickets to use local transit systems for needed stops at your destination community. One-way trips are available for a fare of \$10.00

WHO CAN RIDE THE ON THE BRRT ROUTE?

Anyone can ride the bus! People of all ages and any income level who are unable to obtain a ride or unable to use other transportation modes can use this service. Students, adults, and elderly residents can use the bus to get to activities, medical, dental, business appointments and more! The BRRT Route Service is for anyone who is in need of transportation. It is for anyone who has trouble getting to doctor or business appointments, local shopping needs, or other social and business events. The BRRT Route Service is for anyone who does not want to impose on friends, relatives, or neighbors for a ride. The BRRT Route Service is available for anyone who doesn't have anyone to call for a ride! *These cross-county routes were implemented to make transportation available to everyone!*

WHEN IS THE BRRT BUS AVAILABLE IN MY COMMUNITY?

Buffalo Ridge Regional Transit Route travels through each of the County Seats four times each day ~ 16 times a week!



MONDAY:

Routes P100 and P200 Begin in Pipestone.
Routes M100 and M200 Begin in Slayton.



TUESDAY:

Routes N100 and N200 Begin in Worthington.
Routes R100 and R200 Begin in Luverne.



WEDNESDAY:

Routes M300 and M400 Begin in Slayton.
Routes P300 and P400 Begin in Pipestone.



THURSDAY:

Routes R300 and R400 Begin in Luverne.
Routes N300 and N400 Begin in Worthington.

HOW DO I USE THE BRRT BUS ROUTE SERVICE?

You can ride the Buffalo Ridge Regional Transit bus at any community along the route. As the BRRT Bus passes through the community, residents can also be picked up at any "pathway" point. The pathway point is any street or intersection that the BRRT Bus is traveling on. All pick-up times are based on the time it takes the BRRT Bus to travel to and from each community on the route schedule. Whenever possible - please call Four County Dispatch at 888-735-2537 or your local Transit Agency to confirm your ride and pick-up location!

PASSENGER GUIDELINES

Passenger Pick-up Time

Passengers need to be ready for the bus at the designated pick-up time given by the dispatcher. Times are always subject to weather, demand and availability.

Seat Belt Policy

BRRT requires all passengers to wear seat belts. Minnesota state law requires all passengers to use the provided seat belts. Adults that accompany children under 20 pounds are required to provide their own child safety seat. Passengers using a wheelchair are required to use the provided shoulder and lap belts.

Fare Collection Procedures

All passengers must provide a fare. This may be in the form of cash, punch cards, or other approved payment. All Medical Assistance riders must have pre-approval from Human Services. Drivers never carry change. Passengers must provide the exact fare and be deposited into the farebox.

Passenger Guidelines

- Respect the driver, fellow passengers and bus.
- No fighting, harassment, intimidating, or horseplay.
- No use of tobacco or drugs.
- No weapons on the bus.
- No electronics are used on the bus unless using headphones.
- Passengers must be ready to board the bus when it stops.
- Passengers must stay in their seats until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- BRRT passengers may carry up to 4 bags or parcels on the bus.
- Avoid blocking the aisle and/or lift area.
- Bikes and other large items are not allowed on the bus.
- No hazardous materials are allowed on the bus.
- Passenger behavior should not interfere with or impair the operation of the bus.

Passenger Conduct

Passengers are to be courteous to fellow passengers and the driver at all times. BRRT reserves the right to refuse rides to any passenger displaying rude or obnoxious behavior. Passengers will be given a verbal warning for bad behavior, and could be suspended from riding if behavior continues.
