Review of April Minutes: Minutes are approved

Heath Landsman as the Emergency Management System Director and also is the Chief Deputy for Murray County, attended the meeting to share information about EMS. Heath has assigned Deputy Devin Gillette to be responsible of communication for the Village of Hadley and it's residents.

1) You can declare a State of Emergency whenever it is necessary for a disaster. 2) The 4H building is designated as a shelter and the school would probably be available for shelter if necessary. 3) The Red Cross was on standby. 4)FEMA Funds for Murray County if \$32K and this area from the State is \$16K. Townships are still waiting for FEMA funds from last July 2018. The main thing is to make sure to document any issue that could potentially be a problem. FEMA is going to start to allow the States to take the lead. MN has a QuickStart program that could be forgiven if you have an agreement to stay in your home for an agreed upon time. SBA will help with home owners and businesses.

Dean Larson had water backing up in his basement when the power was shut off. Judy will contact Missy Biren regarding our insurance covering his \$1k deductible for cleanup. Dean spoke again about a "private line" that he states 12 people belong to. And we will contact Bollig to get a map of the sewer system to see where this could possibly be hooked in to.
