

## City of Hadley Council Minutes

18 June 2014

Meeting called to order at 6:30.

In attendance: Rick Like, Bonnie Peterson, Dale Pavlis, Nick Pieske, Henry Veldhuisen and Judy LaBoda

Minutes were approved with one correction that Dale Pavlis will not be taking the water test, but should read Dave Voss possibly will.

General fund is approved.

Liquor fund is approved. Myron has received the paperwork for the ATM and should be installed in the next week or so.

Water/sewer fund approved.

Old Business:

- Community Center- the floor tile is in and it should be done within a week. Once the floor is in, it needs to be striped and waxed. Jim Gertsema has agreed to do that work and will donate some of his time.
- Deb Lee and she did not have water in her garage. The alley needs to be rebuilt. Rick suggested we should contact Muecke Sand and Gravel to have them dig out the alley and install a base of rock and sand.
- ATM will be installed next week.
- Xcel energy – The lighting was installed in Wildflower Pointe and nothing installed at Summit Lane.
- Rick spoke with Brian Solem regarding repair of his sprinkler system. He is putting the repair of his sprinkling system off as he plans to make repairs to his barn. Rick informed him that he was having the connections removed by Bob so there will not be any water sprinkling done by anyone from that flush valve.
- Murray County veteran's memorial – Rick waiting to speak with Merlyn Anderson regarding the legalities of the City making a donation.
- Water condition? Water looks clear.
- Open House? July 8<sup>th</sup> from 4-7 at the treatment plant. Judy will send notices with the statement.
- Street sign- need sign post measured at 10 feet. Judy will talk to Justin at Hadley Steel.

News Business:

- Posting of information at the Elevator, Hadley Steel?, the bar and the bulletin board at the Community Center.
- Agri Lime donated by Hadley Elevator. T&J trucking hauled it to Hadley.
- Peggy Platt's back yard has sunk since the water/sewer system was installed. Motion by Bonnie and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dale to install black dirt to take care of it. Bonnie will take care of it.
- Purchase of water for upcoming water project in the Lake Wilson area – there will be work in the next year. The water would be used for dust control. Little information available.

Brian Bollig mentioned there is a flush valve on the side of the pump house to be used to drain the residue from the bottom of the holding tank.

- New Concession Stand?
- Help for Bob? We will look into liability.
- Property assessment of Sewer and Water. Rick is visiting with Merlyn Anderson about this now and we may change this.
- Nick brought up an issue by Leona Johnson's. There was much discussion about it. Nick will oversee this and make sure it is correct.
- The gravel that comes to the door by the pump house has washed away from the recent rains. There was mention of installing a gutter. Judy will ask Hadley Steel to reshape the drive way.
- Henry brought up spraying for bugs as this will be a season for mosquitos. Maybe do the park, the ball field and low lands. It was tabled.

Motion to pay bills by Henry and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Nick. Motion passed.

Motion to adjourn by Henry and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dale. Motion passed.
