City of Hadley Council Meeting Minutes

Attendees: Rick Like, Bonnie Petersen, Henry Veldhuisen, Nick Pieske, Dale Pavlis, Myron Bennett, Judy LaBoda

Meeting called to order at 6:30 by Mayor Like.

Review of the minutes: minutes approved

General fund: approved – Judy will check into the lawn maintenance and water fund being split out regarding hours for Bob Wornson.

Liquor fund: good month for Liquor store sales. Good job Myron!

Review of Sewer/Water account: Approved

Old Business:

- Water/sewer assessment – Rick received a document from Merlyn Anderson – City Atty. regarding assessing the water/sewer to the taxes. The City would need to establish a public hearing including credible numbers to share with the citizens. Rick will contact Merlyn about length of time the assessment would be to each household and dollars due.
- Street lights – Judy will again follow up with Larry Henderson, regarding solar lighting, and invite him to a meeting.
- Relocating compressor – Myron will take care of contacting Sahlstroms to make that change.
- Electric heat for the council room- Rick spoke with Steve Hartle and asked for an estimate to repair or replace the heater in the council room.
- Henry spread dirt at Leona Johnson's, the park, the restrooms, and around some of the trees. The rest can be used elsewhere in the community.

New Business:

- Election results - The City of Hadley has 42 registered voters and only 29 absentee ballots were submitted. There were 2 write in votes for mayor, 8 write in votes for council seats. Mayor Like was re-elected; Bonnie Petersen was re-elected to her council position; Dale Pavlis was elected to a council position.
- Budget – next month
- Health insurance for Myron – will follow up next month,
- Dock – to be donated to the City of Hadley. It is in fair shape and has all of the deck boards and needs some repair. It needs to be moved to the City. It could be hauled to Hadley Steel to be repaired. Rick will find someone to haul it. Dale made a motion to accept the dock as a donation and send to Hadley Steel to be repaired. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Henry. Motion carried.
- Motion by Nick and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bonnie to not waive the monetary tort limits for the insurance for the City. Motion carried.
- Motion by Henry, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dale to change the Council Meeting time to 6 PM beginning in December – and to continue to the March meeting- Motion carried

Motion by Henry and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bonnie to pay the bills.

Motion by Dale and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bonnie to adjourn.
