12 January 2015

Meeting called to order by Mayor Like at 6:01.

Swearing in of Mayor Like; Bonnie Petersen, Dale Pavlis

Guest: Tom Ackerman – will return next Month as his underwriter was not available with a quote.

Visitors: Mike Zinnel

Review of General Fund: approved

Review of Liquor Fund: Approved – Pool tournaments on Friday's have been doing well. Park/Rec will be running meat raffles every other Saturday afternoon as a fund raiser for the concession stand. Judy will contact those that are out 90 days or more that if they don't pay or get caught up, their water will be shut off.

Review of Water/Sewer Fund: Judy mentioned there are two meters that are not working. We will contact Ferguson regarding repair. There was detailed discussion regarding the power outages and how the water gets "stirred-up" and takes a couple of hours to settle down.

Old Business:

- Water/Sewer assessment – Judy to supply the numbers from the BAB for total paid to date.
- Motion was made to contribute \$500 per month to Myron's HSA, subject to Myron's approval of his recommendation; 2nd by Henry; approved.
- Fire Contract Meeting – attended by Rick and Dale - \$813.02 billed to the City of Hadley – Hadley Elevator submitted the bill to their insurance company for reimbursement to the City of Slayton Fire Department, as a result of the fire in a grain bin. Rick and Dale were impressed with the professionalism of the Slayton Fire Department. They commented on the rate per section that is recommended by the fire department for the townships and how they were able to maintain the low cost. City of Slayton contributes a large portion to the Department. Henry made a motion to accept the contract and bill; 2nd by Bonnie. Motion carried; Judy will pay that billing.
- Budget- Rick to get the budget numbers completed next month.
- Dale had spoken to Lawson's and asked them to finish the playground equipment repair project.
- Break down – of Bob Wornson's wages – Judy will work on.
- Inventory – went well....Nick Pieske did not attend. (nor did Judy).
- Mike Zinnel – asking about the assessments; and when we can expect something to occur.

New Business:

- Subsurface Sewage Treatment System Ordinance? Rick will contact Chris Hanson regarding this.

- City received a letter from the U of M – in relation to the Des Moines River watershed and asking for council members that may be interested in being contacted regarding their mission. Asking for email addresses for city staff that could attend.
- Trustees of the Hadley Sportsmans Club will disband and disburse the money – Mike Zinnel will issue a check to the City of Hadley Park/Rec fund for environmental or conservation projects. This money will be a designated fund for future projects.

If council members attend meetings outside of the monthly council meeting, you must turn in a slip for reimbursement as a special meeting.
