

Pipestone County Fair Antiques Tractor Pull Rules

Class 2 – 1959 & Older

3000, 3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500, 7500, & 8500

Tractors that have some minor work done on the will be in Class 1.

No cut tires in Class 2.

No shifting of TA's lowest gear only.

210 sq. in tire size max for Classes 3500 to 5500.

255 sq. in tire size max for Classes 6000 & 6500.

320 sq. in tire size max for Classes 7500 & 8500.

Tractors must be stock appearing.

3.50mph speed limit. 20% over on RPMS

Class 3 1959 & Older

3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500, 7500, & 8500

CUT tires allowed 18.48 max, any rim width.

No shifting of TA's.

5 mph speed limit. 20 % over on RPMS.

18.4 – 38 Max tire size

Fenders and high back seats required

Deadman Throttle recommended

Class 4 -1959 & Older

Tractors can use any gear. 8 MPH

Shifting of TAs allowed, open speed

500 rpm over manufacturer high idle.

18.4 x 38 max tire size.

Deadman throttle, fenders, and high back seats required.

Class 5 - 1959 & Older

4500, 5000, 5500, 6500

TAs allowed, open speed

Cut tires allowed 18.4-38 Max

Deadman Throttle recommended

2 cyl – 1800 RPMS

4 cyl – 2500 RPM's

6 cyl – 3000 RPM's

Side shields, Scatter blanket, Kill Switch, Flywheel Protection for for 2 cyl. JD's

Fenders and high back seats required.

Rules for Farm Stock Classes:

This Class is Intended for working or collector type two-wheel drive tractors in their original configuration. This class is not for stripped down purpose built pulling tractors.

3.5 MPH through 8500 lbs.

5 MPH 9500 lbs. and up to 15,500 lbs. Max 20" hitch 9500 and up.

If you have to ask if it's allowed you probably don't belong in this class.

- 1) You must provide your own twist clevis or bolt on loop of adequate strength with at least a 3" wide and a 3.5" long opening.
- 2) All tractors will have a horizontal hitch point. No homemade hitches or weight brackets. Hitch must be rigid in all directions.
- 3) Tractor will pull from original draw bar, maximum height is 18 inches.
- 4) Wheel weights or factory front weights are allowed. NO suitcase weights unless offered for the tractor.
- 5) Parts used must be in the original parts book.
- 6) NO homemade accessory deletes covers, no side shields unless factory equipped.
7. No aluminum/chrome wheels or fuel tanks.
- 8) Tractor must be stock in appearance; chrome pipes are allowed.
- 9) Engines will not exceed the factory hi idle speed.
- 10) No pressed steel rims in place of factory cast, one size over tires allowed.
- 11) All tractors will be open for inspection at all times.

12,500 Maximum weight on scale, tractors over that will need to weigh at New Horizon!!

General rules and considerations for all Classes:

- Drivers under 18 years of age required parent or guardian signature.
- RPM's are listed in the class rules
- NO Radials, duals, chains, V8 tractors or pickups.
- Tip bars required in classes 2, 3, 4 and 5. Kill Switches required for Class 2 and 3.
- All drivers must operate their tractors in a safe manner, remain seated, no bouncing and no jerking the skid. Drivers must obey the flagman.
- Drawbar must be stationary with a 3" hole and no more than 1.25" of material left and the rear of the hole. 18" height for class 2, 20" height for class 2, 3, 4, and 5. No closer than 18" from the center of rear axle. Fast hitches must be pinned solid and locked from movement.
- Front weights cannot be more than 11" from the center of the rear axle. Rear weights must not extend beyond rear tires.
- Any part falling off the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in a disqualification.
- Hook fee is \$20.00 per hook. Max 3 hooks per tractor. Cash paybacks for all Classes.
- No LP or Nitrous Oxide injection, blowers allowed only on Detroit Diesels. No curved exhaust pipes.
- Protests must be made while tractor is still hooked to the skid, protest must be made by another puller in the same class.
- No homemade intake or exhaust manifolds. Ag type carburetor only.
- Excessive alcohol consumption, foul or abusive language or violation of any of the rules are grounds for disqualification. No refund will be given.
- Tractors must have same number of cylinders as equipped from the factory.
- Fuel will be gasoline, diesel fuel or LP gas, E85 or E99.
- Throttles must have a positive stop and a working governor.
- All tractors are subject to a RPM check at any time.
- All decisions by track officials are final, other rules apply.
- All tractors will weigh before pulling.
- Please drive slowly and safely through the pit area. 5 mph maximum.
- All curved exhaust pipes must point forward.
- All Tractor drivers must be 12 years of age or older.
