Patients may qualify for hospice due to a wide range of conditions, including but not limited to:

- ❖ Advanced cancer
- ❖ Alzheimer's disease or other forms of dementia
- ❖ Congestive heart failure (CHF) or other advanced heart disease
- ❖ Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) or other progressive lung diseases
- ❖ End-stage renal disease (ESRD) or other advanced kidney disease
- ❖ End-stage liver disease (ESLD) or other serious liver conditions
- ❖ HIV/AIDS with declining health
- ❖ Sepsis or other multi-organ failure
